
On any given night in Australia 1 in 200 people are homeless



Who is homeless?

1 in 200 people are homeless on any given night. 17, 845 are under 12 years old & 10,913 are 12 - 18 years old.



Why are they homeless?

24% Domestic and family violence

20% Financial issues

16% Housing crisis

11% Inadequate or inappropriate dwellings

8% Other relationship issues


- 5% Other accommodation issues
- 4% Health issues
- 2% Transition from custody agreement
- 1% Itinerant
- 1% Lack or family/community support
- 8% Other

Journey of homelessness



Dad and Mum fight alot.

One night the police came and we had to go to a shelter.





The service helped Mum find a job, buy us school uniforms and books (even a desk so we could do homework).



I fought with Mum all the time. She said I needed to behave or leave, so I left.

I slept at friends houses for a couple of weeks. Each night I tried to find somewhere to stay. Sometimes it was at someone's house I'd never met and some nights on the street. I contacted a youth service.

They helped with somewhere to stay, now I'm in my own place.

What happens when you're homeless?

- · Move Schools or stop going altogether
- Lose your friends and/or family
- · Miss out on school uniforms, books, excursions
- You get sick
- You can get depressed/anxious
- You do whatever you can to survive
